Thank you for joining us for our Open Day.

Please use this guide to plan your visit, drop in on some music rehearsals and seek out any members of staff you would like to meet.

Please arrive via the Stoller Hall entrance on Hunts Bank, opposite Victoria Station. Entry is strictly from 10am.

We recommend that you arrive before 11am, when there will be an introductory talk from the Joint Principals.

Light refreshments are available in the Oglesby Atrium on the ground floor of the New School Building.

For the first time at Open Day, we invite prospective students to join in with our open rehearsals. If you have an instrument, you may store it in room G.04 on the ground floor of the New School Building. Instruments are stored at your own risk and Chetham's shall not be liable for any loss of any kind.

Toilets - including accessible toilets - are available on every floor of the New School Building. Toilets in all other buildings are not accessible to Open Day visitors.

No visitor photography, audio or visual recording is permitted on the premises.

Chetham's Library - the medieval visitor attraction within the school grounds - is closed today.
