The **friendly staff** can **show us** where they are



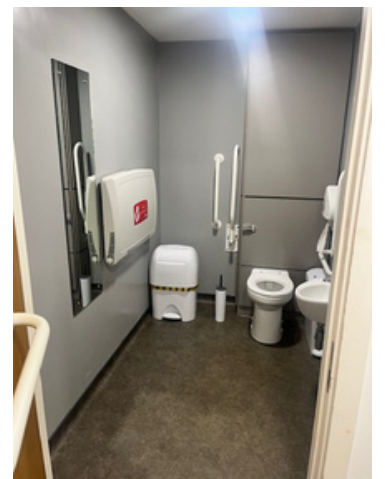
Toilets
