The Storyteller and Musician

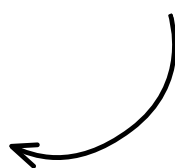
We will meet **Emily** and **Sarah**

Sarah will make **music**



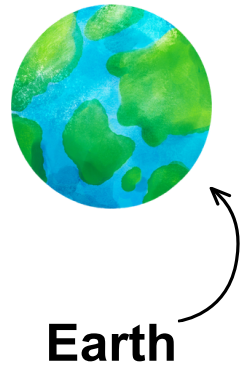
Emily

The Planets we will visit are

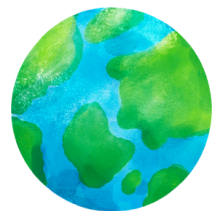


On each planet we will
